

# Visitor Restriction Guidelines

(As of 11-16-2020)

<p><b>General Entry</b></p>	<p>Limited points of entry to facilities with active screening.</p> <p>Mask required.</p>
<p><b>Symptoms</b></p>	<p>Visitors allowed due to exception or special need must be without fever or symptoms</p>
<p><b>All COVID-19 Patients (See Exceptions Below)</b></p>	<p>No visitors allowed for suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Alternative mechanisms for visitation include telephone calls or personal virtual devices.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Med-Surg/Intensive care units</b></p>	<p>No Visitors unless a determined exception by the clinical staff</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Alternative mechanisms for visitation include telephone calls or personal virtual devices.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Outpatient and Ambulatory Clinics Emergency Department Urgent Care Surgery</b></p>	<p>No Visitors unless a determined exception by the clinical staff</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Alternative mechanisms for visitation include telephone calls or personal virtual devices.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Pediatric Patients</b></p>	<p>Two parents are permitted for the duration of the stay</p>
<p><b>Exceptions to Visitor Restrictions (Per Hospital Discretion)</b></p>	<p>May be made for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visitors under age of 18 who are parents of a minor patient.</li> <li>• End of life situations.</li> <li>• Decision-making by healthcare power of attorney.</li> <li>• The patient's emotional well-being.</li> <li>• Patients with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD).</li> <li>• Laboring patients.</li> </ul>
